



Fulbright Grants for Luxembourg Citizens (2020-2021)

The Fulbright program has a proud history of offering study grants to Luxembourg and American scholars, lecturers, researchers, and professionals to pursue advanced studies in the United States or Luxembourg. Fulbright is supported by the governments of the United States and Luxembourg as well as by some private sponsors.

Who is eligible? Luxembourg citizens who wish to pursue an advanced degree, research, complete certain professional programs, or teach German or French language at an American university are eligible.

How do I apply? You apply directly to the U.S. Schools of your choice as well as applying for a Fulbright grant. To learn about programs and application procedures, Luxembourgers can visit <http://Luxembourg.usembassy.gov/>

What is a study grant? A study grant is up to \$20,000 to assist with one year of studies for an advanced degree program or other designated program; the grant can be used for tuition, books, living expenses and other costs.

What is the deadline for application? December 1, 2019 to study or conduct research in the 2020-2021 academic year.
